Dear Sir/Madam,

Since 28th November 2013 Finland recognizes the Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport (=Provisional Passport). If the nationality of the holder in this document is Israel, he/she is visa free to Finland for short periods (max. 90 days in 6 months period). In case the nationality in the travel document is something else and requires a visa on basis of nationality, then a visa is needed.
