Dear Sir/Madam,

Thank you for your email of 5 November 2012.

Please be informed that under the current visa arrangement, nationals of Israel holding valid Israeli passport may visit the HKSAR visa-free for a stay up to 90 days. For stateless travel document holders, they are always required to have visa for the HKSAR except in direct transit by air and when the person does not leave the airport transit area.

In general, save for the requirement of holding a valid travel document, visitors should satisfy an immigration officer on arrival that they meet normal immigration requirements [e.g. they are bona fide visitor; they have adequate funds to cover the duration of their stay without working; they hold onward or return tickets (unless in transit to the Mainland of China or Macao), etc.] before permission to land may be given.
