Dear Ms. Agizim,

I confirm you that holders of an "Israeli Travel document in lieu of national passport" are not required to apply for a Visa in order to enter the Schengen Area (Italy included) for up to 90 days within a 180 days period for tourism, business, study or for sport competition. For all other purposes or for visits longer than 90 days, a long-stay national visa (or visa type "D") is required and must be obtained from the Embassy or Consulate of the Schengen Member State of destination before entering the country.

The Israeli citizenship must be stated on the passport.
