1. By the present letter we are kindly asking you to provide us with additional information concerning the question of visiting Republic of Latvia by **Israeli nationals possessing of Provisional passport issued by the State of Israel.**
2. In accordance with the new information published on the Official portal of Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Latvia: "**As of July 10, 2014, citizens of the State of Israel, who are bearers of the "Travel Document in lieu of National Passport" will no longer need a Schengen visa for entering the Republic of Latvia. Citizens of the State of Israel can stay in Latvia without visa for up to 90 days in a 180-day period.**" (attached is a copy of a printout from the official portal – **appendix 1**).
