2 We are pleased to inform you that Israeli provisional passport holders are not required to apply for a visa to enter Singapore.

3 Upon arrival in Singapore, visitors are generally granted a short term Visit Pass if they are able to meet the following entry requirements:

- Passport valid for at least 6 months;
- Confirmed onward/return tickets (where applicable);
- Sufficient fund to maintain themselves during their stay in Singapore;
- Visa, if applicable; and
- Entry facilities, including visas, to their onward destinations.
- Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate, if applicable

4 The issue of a pass is at the discretion of Immigration & Checkpoints Authority officers at the time of arrival at Singapore checkpoints.
