Dear Sir, Madam,

We are pleased to inform you that the Principality of Andorra does not require any type of visa for short stays (up to 90 days) for touristic purposes.

Nevertheless, as Andorra is not a member of the Schengen Area and the access to the Principality is made through France or Spain, any national from a third-country (Israel in this case) travelling to Andorra must get information from the French or Spanish Embassies or Consulates (depending on the country of entrance) about the need of a Schengen visa, and when deemed necessary, about the visa obtaining procedures.

When a Schengen visa is required, third-country nationals shall apply for a **double-entry or a multiple entry Schengen visa** depending on how many times you will enter the Schengen area from Andorra.

We hope this information will be useful, and we remain at your disposal for any further information.
