Dear Mr. Goldman,

Referring to your query, we would like to confirm the position regarding the holders of the Israeli Travel document in lieu of National Passport, which we informed you about in July 2015:

Nationals of the State of Israel, holders of a Travel Document in lieu of National Passport, **do not require a visa** for transit through or intended stays in the territory of the Republic of Croatia not exceeding 90 days in any 180-day period.

It is understood that the Israeli nationality of the holder is indicated in such a Travel Document.

The period of validity of the Travel Document must be valid for at least 3 months after leaving Croatia.
