Thank you for your email regarding travelling to Denmark as an Israeli citizen with an Israeli Travel Document, in lieu of national passport.

If you are an Israeli citizen with an Israeli Travel Document, in lieu of national passport, you can travel visa-free to Denmark under certain requirements. One of the requirements is:

The travel document must be valid for three months past the intended date of departure from the Schengen area. Moreover, the travel document must have been issued within the past 10 years. The Embassy also recommends you to check with the relevant airline, as they might have their own requirements regarding validity of passports.

In your e-mail to the Embassy you attached a copy of this file, and as you can see Denmark recognizes the Israeli Travel Document, in lieu of national passport.
