In case one wants to visit Japan for one of the mentioned purposes, the permission for stay period is given based on the return ticket within categories of 15, 30, 90 days? So return ticket is obligatory?

In other words-

In case of 10 days tourist visit the category of permit will cover 15 days anyway?

And case of 20 days visit the permit will be given for 30 days?

In general, a holder of **the travel document in lieu of national passport** for Israeli citizens is not required to obtain a visa prior to his visit to Japan when the purpose of his visit is commercial, attendance at conferences, tourism, visits to relatives/acquaintances, etc. for the duration of 90 days or less.

If you go to Japan as a short term visitor within the scope of the visa exemption agreement between two countries, the maximum period of stay that could be granted by Japanese Immigration officer after examination at entry ports upon your arrival is up to 90 days.

• Period of Stay

The period of stay granted at the time of the landing permission shall be the shortest period out of "15 days", "30 days" or "90 days," that is long enough to cover the purpose of the stay of the foreign national.

**Border Measures from May 8, 2023**

As the classification of COVID-19 in the Infectious Diseases Control Law is to be changed on May 8, 2023, all border measures, including provisional measures, to prevent the spread of COVID-19 will be lifted on May 8, 2023.

**Border Measures until May 8, 2023**

The Japanese government strongly recommends that you use the Visit Japan Web to upload your vaccination certificate or PCR negative result before traveling to Japan.

Before departure from Israel, you must register with Visit Japan Web to upload your vaccination certificate (or pre-departure PCR test result), and complete immigration and customs questionnaires. Once approved, the site will generate 3 approvals (some of them with QR code) that you'll need to show on arrival in Japan.
