Dear Mr. Goldman,

Let me confirm that Slovak Republic officially recognizes following types of Israeli travel documents (which means that these passports present an acceptable proof of identity for the purpose of entering Slovak Republic):

- 1. Ordinary (blue) passport** - holders of this type of passport can travel to Slovakia under visa-free regime up to 90 days for tourist purposes.
- 2. Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport (red)** - is issued to citizens of Israel who, for certain reasons, are not entitled to an ordinary Israeli passport. Based on the Agreement between the Government of the Slovak Republic and the Government of the State of Israel on the abolition of the visa requirement for holders of valid travel documents, the holder of a valid Travel document in lieu of national passport may enter the territory of the Slovak Republic and stay in the territory of the Slovak Republic for 90 days within any 180- day period without a visa.
- 3. Travel Document (also red)** - is issued to a foreigner and its holder must have a visa to enter the Slovak Republic. Holders of this type of passport can apply for a Schengen Visa for the stay up to 90 days or Slovak National Visa (more than 90 days – want to apply for some kind of residence permit in Slovakia).
- 4. Diplomatic and service passports** – no visa requirement.
