Dear Mark Goldman,

Israeli provisional passport is valid for travelling to Finland if the nationality is stated on the passport's information page as ISRAELI.

Since last fall 2022 Finnish Border Guard <https://raja.fi/en/frontpage> does not accept Israeli passports which validity has been extended. As far as the Embassy knows these are passports which have originally been issued for ten years, expired and then extended.

All the travel documents need to be valid minimum 3 months after the completion of the trip.
